SH-CA : Siberian Husky—California

As a fund raiser, the SH-CA activity will be held in conjunction with the 2007 Siberian Husky Club of America, Inc., National Specialty, October 30 through November 3, 2007, at the Doubletree Hotel Sonoma Wine Country, Rohnert Park, CA.

A limited edition sculpture of a “generic” Siberian Husky has been created for this activity. It is approximately 7” x 7” x 3” in size, and white in color. These dogs will be available for sponsorship and decoration. The SH-CA sponsors may decorate the dogs as creatively as possible (within the Rules and Regulations, below). The decorated dogs will be returned to the Specialty Show Committee prior to the start of the 2007 National Specialty.

The SH-CA entries will be on display at the *Generations Gala and Wine Tasting* at the Specialty (Wednesday night, October 31, 2007). At that time, they will be entered into a competition for award placement. Those voting will be asked to make a donation per vote. The SH-CA selected Best of Breed by the voting will be awarded a Trophy and Rosette, and those entries placing 2nd, 3rd, and 4th, will receive Rosettes.

After the winners have been announced, the SH-CA entry dogs will be placed into a silent auction, each for purchase by the highest bidder. At the close of bidding, the lucky winning bidders will pay for their purchases and the SH-CA dogs will go to their new homes. The sponsor of the SH-CA entry that is sold for the highest amount will also receive a Trophy.

Siberian Husky—California (SH-CA)

Rules and Regulations:

1. There will be a maximum of 25 dogs available for sponsorship.
2. Sponsorship will cost \$30 per dog.
3. An individual, club, group, etc., may sponsor an entry.
4. Sponsorship entitles the sponsor to receive a dog for decorating, to decorate it (following these Rules and Regulations), to return it as directed herein, giving up all claims to the dog by virtue of donating the decorated dog to the 2007 SHCA National Specialty to be placed in competition and sold at auction.
5. Due to the limited number of dogs available for sponsorship, each sponsor may initially receive only one dog. However, if dogs remain unsponsored by 08/15/2007, additional dogs may be available for sponsorship by existing sponsors.
6. Prior to the Specialty, Sponsorship includes the following:
 - a. Sponsor will request or download a sponsorship form, complete it, and return it complete with a check for \$30.00
 - b. Sponsor will be sent a boxed and bubble-wrapped dog in this timeframe: For paid sponsorship forms received prior to July 15, 2007, boxed dogs will begin being sent on July 15, 2007. For any sponsorship forms received thereafter, dogs will be mailed as soon as practicable.
 - c. Although encouraged to attend, sponsors need not be present at the 2007 Specialty to participate.
 - d. For any dog arriving damaged, please try to superglue the dog back together. If this fails, report the damaged dog immediately to the SH-CA chairman for replacement.
 - e. Sponsors will decorate the SH-CA dogs as creatively and in good taste as they wish, with the following limitations:
 - i. Dogs may be painted, glittered, appliquéd, or decorated in any number of fashions
 - ii. Dogs may be decorated to look like Siberian Huskies, or to be used as artist's "canvases" and decorated more creatively
 - iii. The approximate size and shape of the original SH-CA must be kept (e.g., the dog may not be placed in a scene)
 - iv. Dogs may not be decorated lewdly
 - v. Dogs may not be dangerous (e.g., sharp objects, sticky, slimy, etc.)
 - vi. Although dogs may be decorated to depict a specific dog, no existing kennel, person, or actual dog should be identified by name or other identification method.
 - vii. The overall dog composition may not be changed (e.g., extra limb added, body part broken)
 - viii. Should any dog be damaged during decorating, please try to fix it with super glue. If that is not possible, contact the SH-CA Chairman immediately to see if a replacement is available.
 - ix. All decorated dogs should be able to withstand packaging and shipping as well as gentle handling.
 - x. Sponsors may name their SH-CA as long as rule vi., above, is followed.
 - f. All decorated dogs must be returned in their provided boxes by mail or other delivery method by October 15, 2007 to the SH-CA Chairman. Should you have any questions about this, contact the Chairman
7. Prior to the Specialty, the SH-CA Chairman will be responsible for the following:
 - a. Receive all requests for sponsorship.
 - b. Fulfill all sponsorship requests.
 - c. Be available to answer questions.
 - d. Receive decorated dog entries.
 - e. Transport all entries to the Specialty
8. At the Specialty, the SH-CA Chairman will be responsible for the following:
 - a. Display the entries at the Generations Gala and Wine Tasting
 - b. Provide a voting receptacle for each entrant
 - c. Collect donations and distribute tickets for voting
 - d. Count the "votes," and determine the winners
 - e. Award prizes
9. At the Specialty, the Sponsors may encourage and actively participate in voting (and in "buying" votes)
10. After the voting is complete, the SH-CA Chairman will do the following:
 - a. Have silent auction sheets available for each entry
 - b. Monitor and encourage bidding
 - c. Close the bidding, and determine winning bidders
 - d. Award prizes
 - e. Collect payments and provide SH-CA dogs to their new owners
11. During the silent auction, Sponsors may encourage and actively participate in bidding.
12. Bidders (or their named and instructed proxies) must be present during the Silent Auction.
